

COVID-19 KITCHEN & FLOORING INSTALLATION POLICY

Work carried out in people's homes, for example by tradespeople can continue, provided that the tradesperson is well and has no symptoms.

We will ensure that Public Health England guidelines, including maintaining a two-metre distance from any household occupants, are followed to ensure everyone's safety.

No work should be carried out in any household which is isolating or where an individual is being shielded, unless it is to remedy a direct risk to the safety of the household, such as emergency plumbing or repairs, and where the tradesperson carrying out the work is willing to do so.

No work will be carried out by a tradesperson who has coronavirus symptoms, however mild.

To ensure we are complying with the current advice from Public Health England, we will:

- Keep two metres away from others at all times.
- Ensure we wash our hands numerous times during the day, for 20 seconds using soap and hot water.
- Use hand sanitiser when we are out and about (if soap and water is not available).
- Make sure we wash our hands when we: Arrive on site at any time, Blow our nose, sneeze or cough.
- We will not touch our eyes, nose or mouth.
- Always cough and sneeze into a tissue (or sleeve), then bin the tissue immediately and wash our hands or use a hand sanitising gel.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces regularly, such as our tools, equipment, phone and steering wheel.
- Any items which have been installed will be thoroughly disinfected and deep cleaned before being signed off and us leaving site.
- All relevant PPE will be available on site at all times. This will be changed regularly and disposed of after use if required.
